

## **Immunisation Training for registered Community Pharmacists to administer the seasonal Influenza vaccination programme**

This programme has been developed for Community Pharmacists to enable them to administer the seasonal influenza vaccination programme. It is based in a Clinical governance framework of PCT and Community Pharmacy protocol, HPA National Minimum Standards for Immunisation Training & Core Curriculum for Immunisation Training, DH 'Green Book', letters and DH Training Slides.

The development programme may be tailored to accommodate local organisational protocols and comprises training, observation, supervision and assessment of clinical practice, combined with the development of a portfolio of evidence.

Formative and summative assessment activities are cross-referenced to the NHS KSF. The assessment tool includes expert witness practical assessment as well as discretionary questions.

The interactive training session has been designed to meet the specific needs of this staff group. Whilst highly practical, the activities have been put together to enable Community Pharmacists understand this extension to their role as well as discerning when to refer to the medical practitioner.

Support is provided to the local leader of the initiative with programme activities being tailored to take account of local circumstance.
